TOURNAMENT GENERAL INFORMATION:

DATE:	Friday/Saturday, February 3/4				
NUMBER OF TEAMS:	All 4A Schools, 2 participants at each weight class				
SITE:	Wenatchee High School – Jim Beeson, AD				
SPORT MANAGER:	Reed Hornung, Sunnyside High School				
TOURNAMENT FORMAT:	District Tournament will be a two-day tournament that will begin at 4:00 pm on Friday and 10:00 am on Saturday				
SEEDING:	Coaches will meet at a time yet to be determined to seed wrestlers 1-14. Wrestlers will be seeded by consensus of the coaches. The coaches may use the following criteria: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Varsity League Wins2. Varsity Wins3. Head to Head Competition4. Vote of coaches				
SCORING:	Each person in the tournament will score points for their team.				
TEAM (S) QUALIFYING TO REGIONALS:	The number of wrestlers that qualify for regionals is yet to be determined due to the change in regional alignments.

TOURNAMENT RULES:

RULES:	National Federation rules will be followed, as well as any WIAA wrestling rules. The site manager will explain any ground rules.
GAMES COMMITTEE:	The Games Committee shall consist of the site manager and two participating coaches not involved in the dispute in question. The games committee's duties shall be those identified by the National Federation and WIAA and any other duties deemed appropriate by the Event Director. Decisions of the Games committee are final.
OFFICIALS:	WIAA official selection process will be used to assign officials.
TEAM BENCH:	The team bench is limited to the same number of people as the state guidelines.
CROWD CONTROL:	Pep banners, confetti, mascots, and mechanical or artificial noisemakers, including band instruments used as noisemakers are not permitted at any time during the tournament.
FINANCES:	The tournament manager will send all receipts and expenditures to the NCWAA district director within one week of the end of the tournament.
RESULTS:	The qualifiers for the next level must be reported immediately following the completion of the tournament to the District Director and the WIAA Office.
