- 4. Admission:**
A. Ticket Prices: All tickets sold at the door. Admission prices are:
\$7 for Adults, \$7 for students without ASB,
\$5 for senior citizens, \$5 for children and \$5 for students with ASB.
Children under 6 are free.

PLEASE REMIND YOUR COMMUNITIES THAT SENIORS AND STUDENTS WITH ASB ARE CHARGED ADMISSION IN THE POST-SEASON.

- B. Passes: Supervisors should use their District's approved pass. WSSAAA, WIAA, and WSCA passes are also accepted.**
- C. Cheer Squads (in uniform) of participating schools will be admitted at no charge.**
- 5. Roster and Pass List:** The playoff roster must be entered on www.kingcoathletics.com by Thursday, November 1st. The roster should include the names of the players (14 maximum), 6 designated school personnel, which includes, coaches, managers, statisticians, etc. and 1 school-designated licensed health care provider (such as an Athletic Trainer) for a total of 21 maximum people on your bench.

The roster limit for the tournament is fourteen (14) players. Roster and pass list changes may be made prior to the first match. After the first match, changes will be permitted only after the KingCo tournament is complete, but before the start of the SeaKing District Tournament.

- 5. District Allocations:** The top three finishers in the KingCo Tournament will advance to the SeaKing District Tournament, November 14th and 16th, held at Sammamish HS and Lakeside HS.
- 6. Medical:** The tournament does not provide an athletic trainer. Taping/treatment tables will be available for your athletic trainer to use in treating your athletes. Ice and water will be available.
- 7. Officials/Game Workers:**

- A. Officials and line judges will be provided by Greater Seattle Volleyball Officials
- B. Each school is responsible for providing one scorekeeper and one libero tracker (see General Information below).

8. Games Committee:

The Games Committee shall consist of the tournament manager, the head official, and at least two participating coaches, athletic directors or school administrators not involved in the dispute in question. If a coach feels there has been a misinterpretation of misapplication of a rule, the coach shall notify the game officials following the incident in question, and prior to the resumption of action, that the contest is being played under protest. At that point the official(s) will suspend the contest until a decision of the Games Committee has been determined. The Games Committee will meet immediately. The coach shall be afforded the opportunity to present rationale and justification including the specific rule(s) in question, action taken by the tournament officials, and desired outcome. The Games Committee will deliberate in closed session. The decision of the Games Committee is final.

9. General Information:

- A. The Tournament site will open 1 hour prior to the first match.
PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE EARLY!
- B. Concessions will be available. NO outside food is allowed into the gym.
- C. KingCo Tournament T-shirts will be available for sale.
- D. Each school is responsible for providing their own warm-up volleyballs. The host school will be responsible for furnishing 3 NFHS approved game balls for the matches;
- E. Pre-match warm ups will be 20 minutes as follows: home team 6 minutes, visitors 6, home 4 and visitor 4. (Home team on the bottom of the bracket)
- F. Introductions of all players on both teams will take place before each match.
- G. Team bench: The bench area is to be restricted to the 14 players, coaches and managers.
- H. Match play: Matches will consist of the best 3 out of 5 games. Games will be rally scoring played to 25 points (no cap) with Game 5 (if needed) played to 15 points (no cap).
- I. Table Help: The score keeper, Libero tracker, and score board shall be run by the home team in the match (bottom of the bracket). Each team shall provide the names of the adults who will assume these rolls in the event they are needed. People working the tables are volunteers and will NOT be charged admission.

10. Sportsmanship:

- A. Positive signs and school banners will be permitted.
- B. Artificial noisemakers will not be permitted in the gyms.
- C. Confetti is not allowed. Schools violating this policy, or leaving significant messes created by other materials, may be assessed a cleaning fee.
- D. Flash photography is forbidden during play.
- E. Loud noises or cheering during the opponents' serve is not allowed.
- F. The faculty supervisors from participating schools are to check in with the tournament staff upon arrival, and are expected to actively supervise their fans before, during, and after the match.

11. Locker Rooms: Girls' locker room will be available for use. Coaches are expected to be present in the locker rooms to supervise their athletes. Locks are not provided. Teams should not leave belongings unattended in the locker room.
