- Round 3 11/5/2019 Tuesday Site - Skyline.
  - Losers bracket: 5:30 pm.
  - Winners bracket: Championship game 7:00 pm.

**Games Committee/Protest:** Yonni Mills, Lance Gatter, Cathy Boyce, one coach that is not involved and one official.

- If a coach feels there has been a misinterpretation of misapplication of a rule, the coach shall notify the game officials following the incident in question, and prior to the resumption of action, that the contest is being played under protest. At that point the official(s) will suspend the contest until a decision of the Games Committee has been determined. The Games Committee will meet immediately. The coach shall be afforded the opportunity to present rationale and justification including the specific rule(s) in question, action taken by the tournament officials, and desired outcome. The Games Committee will deliberate in closed session. The decision of the Games Committee is final

**Format:**

- Play at each site will commence with the Pledge of Allegiance or National Anthem for the first match of the day.
- Warm-up: 8-6-6.
  - 8 shared – no serving or hitting over the net.
  - Home team will be the first 6. Visitors the second 6.
- Match: Best three out of five games to 25 points, no cap and deciding game to 15 points.

**Rosters:**

- Rosters shall meet the KingCo, District and State requirements:
  - 14 player maximum.
  - Rosters on [www.kingcoathletics.com](http://www.kingcoathletics.com) will be used for the KingCo Tournament. Please make any needed changes by 10/25/2019.

- Roster changes during post season can only be made between the KingCo Tournament and Districts. Then again between Districts and State.
- Include manager, personnel and trainer.
- JV players must purchase tickets for entry.

### **School Pass List**

- Team roster will be used as the past list for players, coaching staff, managers and trainer.
- Complete and email Yonni the pass list at the end of this document for supervisors and table people. Changes to the pass list can be made by email 24 hour in advance.

### **Table People:**

- Home team (bottom of the bracket) will provide a scorekeeper and a clock operator.
- Visiting team (top of the bracket) will provide a Libero tracker
- Table people are volunteers and will NOT be charged admission.
- Each school is limited to 2 parents on the pass list per day.

### **Medical and Athletic Training:**

- Schools will bring their trainer for their games. If a school's trainer is unable to attend, that school must arrange coverage including supplies.

**Entry:** Gym will open 1 hour 15 minutes prior to match time for teams. Gates will open at least 30 minutes before the first match of the day.

**Warm Up Balls and Water:** Host site will provide warm up balls and water for each team/court. Colored panel game balls are acceptable.

### **Admission Prices:**

KingCo and Bi-District Tournament Matches - All spectators except children under 6 are required to pay an admissions fee. Please communicate the information to your fans prior to the tournament so they will come to the tournament prepared to pay the admissions.

### **Passes:**

KingCo and Bi-District Tournament Matches - KingCo Scouting, WIAA, District 2 Lifetime passes are the only passes that will be honored. Specifically, League Faculty and District passes will not be honored.

### **Sportsmanship/Spirit: Signs, Flags, Noisemakers, Bands**

- Each school will be afforded one official school banner.
- Noisemakers will not be allowed in the gym.. School Supervisors/tournament manager will have authority to confiscate any noisemakers. Security will escort any fan unwilling to give up noisemaker(s) outside of the stadium and that fan will not be allowed to return to the stadium.
- No hand-held signs.

### **Post Season Playoff Supervision:**

Each school participating the volleyball KingCo tournament must have an administrator or designee present at all contests involving their school. It is not the job of the tournament director to address fan behavior during contests.. When problems arise, it is expected that the two school administrators will work together in a timely way to share information and problem solve solutions. It is the school's responsibility to keep fans off the playing floor at all times, particularly at the conclusion of the games.

### **Band Guidelines:**

- Home school bands may perform at home events: first round on 10/30 only. This restriction applies to bands of all forms: full band, pep band, drumline or combos. An adult Director/Advisor **MUST** be present.
- Bands may perform only at time outs, and between games – not before or during serve.
- Individually organized bands or groups are not permitted to perform at any athletic event.
- Schools with bands attending must be cleared by the tournament director 1 week before the start of the KingCo Tournament.
