

Olympic League Divisional Girls Swimming & Diving Invitational

Participating Teams: Bremerton, Kingston, Klahowya, North Kitsap, Olympic, Port Angeles, and Sequim.

Diving: We would like to hold an eleven dive meet. We plan to run the diving competition in its entirety before the swimming competition begins. Diving may run into our swimming warm up time, but this will be discussed among the diving coaches when they arrive.

Diving: Warm up: 12:00p.m.
Start time: 12:45 p.m.

Swimming Timed Finals: Coaches Meeting: 2:00p.m.
Warm up: 2:00 p.m.
Start Time: 3:00 p.m.

Warm up assignments:

2:00 – 2:30 Sequim, Olympic, and Port Angeles

2:30 – 3:00 North Kitsap, Kingston, Klahowya, and Bremerton

The rules for conduct of the meet will be National Federation rules as amended by the Olympic League for this specific meet. Times achieved during this meet will be eligible for District Qualification.

Note: The following rules have been determined regarding athletes with districts/state qualifying times.

This meet is intended for ALL athletes! There are no team limits on the number of entries in each event including relays.

1. Each individual is limited to 2 individual events and 2 relays or 1 individual event and 3 relays.
2. Enter via Hy-Tek (Team Manager) with the attached “Meet Entry Folder”.
Remember to list your divers on the master entry form and bring your completed dive sheets to the meet.
3. Be sure to include entry times IF you want your athlete seeded. **Entries with no time will be entered in the first heats.**
4. **** Reminder: As per our discussion at the preseason Olympic League coaches meeting it was determined that athletes entered with “NT” (no time) will NOT be eligible for awards. If you have an athlete trying an event for the first time and want them eligible for an award, consider an informal time trial at practice so you have an entry time.**

5. Swimmers entered in events in which they already have District and/or State qualifying times need to be marked as “exhibition” during the meet entry process. Box to check is labeled “Exhib” located to the right of athlete’s custom time box.
6. **We will deal with any scratches at the coaches meeting before the start of the meet.**
7. There will be two award flights: gold and silver. Each individual event will be divided in half by seed time with each half (flight) receiving awards for the top six finishers. Relay ribbons will be awarded to the top three teams in one flight only.
8. **Due Date** -- Must be received by **Tuesday, October 22nd** (by midnight-please). Entries should be emailed via the “Meet Entry Folder” using the Hy-Tek program (Team Manager). Questions and/or concerns please contact the meet director:
