Rosters/Records:The tournament will be run Track and you will receive a link. Please have all your wrestlers entered by **NOON, SUNDAY, February 2nd**. Your submitted line up is final. We are only scratching and seeding wrestlers on Monday. There will be no weight changes or additions on Monday in order to increase the integrity of our sub-region and girls' wrestling as a whole. After the seeding meeting on Monday, the brackets will be set. We will only be scratching girls after the Monday meeting.

Allocations: 32-woman Bracket- 2 Per Weight, Top 32 get in, Need State
Record 0-2,1-2,2-2 (pigtails may be used)

Note: All information MUST be supplied on time

Buses/Vans: When teams come in they go straight to the gym and stay there until schools out @2:20- Buses will have to come in on staff side and go around the back and drop off wrestlers and let them in through the locker room, then the bus will have to leave until after 2:45, (the side lot for vans to park may possibly be open Follow signs)

Weigh-In: Picture ID is required for all wrestlers.

Weigh-in will be completed by weight class. The head referee or designee plus a supervisor will serve as weigh-in officials. A coach must be present when wrestlers weigh in. Once a wrestler is in the weight line, she may not leave. Any skin irregularities/diseases must be accompanied by a note from a physician stating the disease is non-communicable. Physicians must have the clearance filled out on a STATE APPROVED FORM.

Mats: A total of 5 mats will be used for the first day of the tournament. Then down to 4 the following day.

Wrestling Area: Only wrestlers, coaches, officials and designated school staff are permitted in the wrestling area.

Spectators seating is limited to the designated bleacher area. Only wrestlers who are currently wrestling, on deck, or in the hole should be on the floor surrounding the mats. All

other wrestlers and coaches should return to their seats until their name has been called. Fans and parents are not permitted on the floor.

1 Day / 2 Day Admission: Adults/Students without ASB: \$8 / \$14

Students with ASB*: \$5 / \$8 Senior: \$2 / \$3

Elementary: \$2 / \$3

-Photos of ID's not accepted. -Cash Only....no checks.

Checkouts: Checkouts OK with hands stamped for re-admittance.

Passes: Three coaches, two managers, eight cheerleaders (in uniform with advisor), and student video, photo, and newspaper representatives (school authorized credentials) are admitted at no charge. Only WCD authorized passes, WSCA (coaches association) passes and WSSAAA (athletic director association) passes will be honored! School District, League, WIAA, WOA, etc. will **NOT** be accepted.

Signage: Bands NOT allowed at the tournament. No signs will be permitted except for official school banners.

Officials: The Western Washington Wrestling Officials Association assigns the officials for the Sub-regional tournaments.

Games Committee: Any disputes occurring at the tournament will be presented to the Tournament Games Committee. Their decision will be final. The Tournament Games Committee will consist of:

- Head Official
- Site Manager
- Tournament Director

Scoring: All Tournament scoring will be conducted as stated in the NFHS Rule Book (Rule 9, section 2).

Team points will be awarded when a school has a wrestler place in the top six (6)

places: ○ First Place = 16 Team Points ○ Second Place = 12 Team Points ○ Third Place = 9 Team Points ○ Fourth Place = 7 Team Points ○ Fifth Place = 5 Team Points ○ Sixth Place = 3 Team Points

Rules: The current WIAA Handbook and NFHS Wrestling Rule Book will be used. Any matter not covered in either book will be at the discretion of the tournament games committee.

Awards: Awards for 1st-, and 4th ribbons for 5th individual places. Team trophy will be awarded for 1st place. WCDIII Certificates will be issued to all participating wrestlers. All 1st through 5th place finishers should be in uniform (no sunglasses or hats) and ready for the podium picture at the conclusion of the tournament.

Qualifiers: The top FOUR (4) wrestlers from each District "A", "B" advance to the Girls WIAA Region II tournament at Decatur High School on Saturday, February 15, 2020. The Regional will consist of an Eight (8) girl bracket. The top four (4) places will advance to the WIAA Mat Classic at the Tacoma Dome on February 21-22, 2020.

Publicity: Coaches are asked to publicize the WCDIII tournament through their school bulletins and home newspapers. Only media photographers with proper credentials will be allowed on the floor.

Concessions: Sponsored by Spanaway Lake High School

Hospitality: Hospitality room will be provided for coaches (no more than 3 per team), officials, and tournament workers only

Locker Rooms: Girls and Boys locker rooms will be available for all wrestlers. Boys locker room will not be available for female use until after the tournament has begun.

Valuables: Each team is responsible for its own valuables. Lockers will not be available.

Warm up Areas: Contact Site manager (AD) for particulars.

Medical Needs: An athletic trainer will be on site. Emergency vehicles can be called upon need. Each team is responsible for its own trainer needs for tape and other supplies.

Townsend, Bremerton, Kingston, North Kitsap, North Mason, Olympic, Port Angeles, Sequim

Tournament Expenses: Expenses for the tournament will be split between the schools involved. We hope revenue generated from admission charges cover the majority of the tournament expenses, but in the event of a loss in revenue, the net loss will be split equally, and an invoice will be sent to each school involved.
