- 7:00 **Doors open for Participants.** Locker rooms and check scales will be available.  
**\*\* Do not arrive on campus prior to 7:00 am – doors will not open early**
- 8:00 Weigh-in will be completed by *weight class*.  
All participants must be in the weigh-in area by **7:55** am. Line-up by weight class.
- 9:00 Doors open to Spectators

- 10:00 **Round 1:** First Round matches.
- 11:55 **Round 2:** Consolation Quarter and Championship Semis
- 1:50 **Round 3:** Consolation Semis
- 2:45 **Round 4:** 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> Place and 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> Place matches
- 3:40 **Finals**  
**Awards**

Mats: Three mats will be used for Rounds 1 through 4. Two mats for finals.

Buses: Athletes should be dropped off by the gym. All buses that stay on site are required to park in the front parking lot closest to SW 320<sup>th</sup> Street after dropping of coaches/athletes by the gym.

Weigh-In: **Picture ID is required for all wrestlers.**  
Weigh-in will be completed by weight class. The head referee plus tournament manager will serve as weigh-in officials. A coach must be present when wrestlers weigh in.

Wrestling Area: Only wrestlers, coaches, officials and designated school staff are permitted in the wrestling area. Spectators seating is limited to the designated bleacher area.

MatClassic Tickets: We will begin selling tickets for MatClassic Tournament Passes at 1:00 PM

**WIAA State Ticket Prices:** Adult \$32, Student/Senior \$23

Checkouts: A ticket stub or hand stamp is required for re-entry.

Passes: Four coaches, two managers, eight cheerleaders (in uniform with advisor), and one student video, photo, and newspaper representatives (school authorized credentials) are admitted at no charge but their names must be on the pass gate list. Only WSCA (coach's association) passes and WSSAAA (athletic director association) passes will be honored! **School District, League, WIAA, WOA, etc. will NOT be accepted.**

Pass Gate Lists: Athletic Directors need to submit pass gate lists via **email to [tjenks@fwps.org](mailto:tjenks@fwps.org) before 3:00pm on Thursday February 13<sup>th</sup>**. Schools who do not email in a pass gate list before February 13<sup>th</sup> will complete one before entering the gym foyer which means time spent outside for everyone in your program while Head Coach is completing this form.

Signage: No signs will be permitted except for official school banners.

Officials: Assigned by the WIAA.

Games Committee: Any disputes occurring at the tournament should be presented immediately to the Head Official. The Head Official will notify the Tournament Manager and he will confer with the Games Committee to hear the protest. The Games Committee decision will be final. The WIAA expulsion rule (23.32 – Conduct eligibility rules and penalties) will be followed.

The Tournament Games Committee will consist of:

- Head Official
- Tournament Manager
- Two coaches will be appointed at the pre-tournament coaches meeting

Awards: Medals for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> place.

No team awards

All wrestlers will wear their school warm-ups on the podium. **NO HATS, HOODS, OR HEAD PHONES ON THE PODIUM OR FOR WIAA STATE PROGRAM PHOTOS**

Qualifiers: The top **FOUR (4)** wrestlers advancing to the WIAA Mat Classic XXVIII at the Tacoma Dome on February 21-22 2020. The fifth place finisher will be the Region 2 alternate to state.

Bracketing: With two sub-regions qualifying four wrestlers each to this regional, the bracket will be the same for each weight class. The bracket will be flipped top-to-bottom every weight.

The letter is the qualifying tournament designation; the number is the tournament placing.

Example Sub A #1 is the Sub-Regional A 1st place
