Schools: 1B: Concordia Christian Academy, Crosspoint Academy, Evergreen Lutheran, Muckleshoot Tribal School, NW Yeshiva, Pacific Christian Academy, Pope John Paul II, Puget Sound Adventist, Quilcene, Rainier Christian, Seattle Lutheran, Tacoma Baptist

2B: Auburn Adventist

Game Days: Tuesdays & Thursday/Friday (or according to officials or school preference)

Game Times: Recommended game times are: JV 4:30 - Varsity 6:00 (varsity start time is immediately following the JV match but no earlier than 6:00 p.m.) - Varsity ONLY 6:00 p.m.

Matches: Varsity –3/5 Rally score to 25

- 5th game to 15, no cap

JV – 3/3 Rally score 25-25-15

- First two games are no cap.
- Third game is no cap if a deciding game.
- Third game is capped at 15 if non-deciding game.
- Teams can decide to play 3-5 sets provided both school and officials assignors approve.

Warm-Up Times: Home team will warm up first. Warm up time is: Eight minutes of shared court time (no hitting) followed by six minutes for the home team, followed by six minutes for the visiting team (with serving as part of your team's six minutes). 8 (shared), 6 (home), 6 (visiting).

Officials: Two Officials for matches (R1 & R2. If one ref only, visiting team has the option of rescheduling). Home team will provide both adult line judges. Visiting team may provide a line judge upon approval by home team.

Rule of Play: National Federation High School Rules. An approved NFHS white or multi-colored leather ball shall be used as selected by the home team. In League Tournament, Home team provides game balls; **Spalding TF-VB5**

Coaches: Home team coach is responsible for updating scores on the league website.

Tiebreakers:

1. Head to Head if tie is between two teams.
2. Multiple team ties will be based on record in games between tied teams.
3. Use total point differential starting with sets won, in games between tied teams.
4. If there is still a multi-team tie, use actual point differential between tied teams.
5. Tie-breakers 3 and 4 are used to narrow the tie down to two teams, then head to head decides the higher placing.
6. Coin Flip

Miscellaneous: Home team is responsible for supplying a qualified official scorekeeper, libero tracker, and two qualified lines-people for every game. If the visiting team has a qualified lines person, they must notify the home team in advance. If both teams utilize a Libero, then the home team provides the tracker. If only one team uses a Libero, then that team provides the tracker.
