STANDARD OPERATION PROCEDURES

UPDATED: October 15, 2018

GENERAL INFORMATION:

DATES: **Week 10 - 2018** will be Thursday, Friday & Saturday, **November 1st, 2nd and 3rd**. DISTRICT 8 Football Playoffs and Non-Playoff Crossover games will be played on those days.

Week 10 - 2019 will be Thursday, Friday & Saturday, **October 31, November 1st and 2nd**. DISTRICT 8 Football Playoffs and Non-Playoff Crossover games will be played on those days.

NUMBER OF TEAMS: 2018 - The top **three (3) 4A** teams and the top **two (2) 3A** teams from the GSL & the MCC will be in the DISTRICT 8 Playoffs (see matchups below).

The remaining four (4) teams from the MCC and the next four (4) GSL teams (according to league finish) will match up in week 10 Non-Playoff Crossover games. The fourth place GSL-3A team will be matched with **Selah** (CWAC) for their week 10 Non-Playoff Crossover game. (see below)

2019 - The top **two (2) 4A** teams and the top **two (2) 3A** teams from the GSL & the MCC will be in the DISTRICT 8 Playoffs (see matchups below).

The remaining five (5) teams from the MCC and the next five (5) GSL teams (according to league finish) will match up in week 10 Non-Playoff Crossover games. The fourth place GSL-3A team will be matched with the **TBA** for their week 10 Non-Playoff Crossover game. (see below)

Non-Playoff crossover games may be played either Thursday or Friday.

Thursday games will be at 6:00pm. Friday games will start at 7:00pm. Local Officials will be used. Film exchange through HUDL. Finances belong to the host team. Changes to the game times and locations can be made by mutual agreement.

PLAYOFF RULES:

- OFFICIALS:** Home officials will be used for all week ten games.
- VISITOR SEATING:** Seating for visiting schools in all rounds of play-off: Reserve 50% of the seating capacity in the home site for the visiting school. Supervisors from the visiting school, home school and police will try to keep home fans out of the visiting seating area.
- SCOUTING AREAS:** The host school will make every attempt to assist third party scouts with placement in appropriate areas.
- FACILITIES/EQUIPMENT:** Equal facilities (locker rooms, benches, etc) for both teams must be provided. Each team will be responsible to provide their own field headphones. Each team will be responsible for their own video equipment/personnel.
- SECURITY:** Security of team and personal items during games: Neither league takes responsibility for theft of visiting team items, however, each host school will make every effort to secure the locker facilities.
- SUPERVISION:** The visiting team will identify a head supervisor. He/she will report to the game manager 1 1/2 hours before game time. The game manager will pay the head supervisor \$20.00 (or going rate) for his/her duties.
- BANDS:** The band should plan to arrive at the game site one hour prior to game time to set up their equipment in assigned section. If they are not able to set up one hour before game time, the band must provide someone to reserve their seating area. The home management must help. Band and drill team members in uniform arriving in a group with their director will be admitted free.
- SUPPORT PERSONNEL:** A courtesy call on the day preceding day by the visiting school indicating the number of spotters, filmers, rooster buses, and any knowledge of radio broadcast should be made by 3:00 PM.
- VIDEO EXCHANGE:** A video exchange of three videos of games is to take place. **Hudl is the preferred method of exchange.** If that is not available an exchange will take place at Ritzville McDonald's (or at a mutually agreed site) on the Saturday no later than 8:00 AM (or at a mutually agreed time) following the final regular season football games. The opposing coach will determine which videos they wish to receive. Teams may agree individually to exchange more videos. **NO THIRD PARTY FILM EXCHANGES.**

- ROSTERS:** Squad size for play-off games: Follow WIAA guidelines for squad numbers.
- PROGRAMS:** Up to the semi-finals, programs are provided by the home team school if they choose to do so. Visiting teams should forward a updated, print ready roster to the home team school as soon as possible.
- EXPENSES:** (WEEK 10) Expenses and income are the responsibility of the home team school and all Profits or Losses are shared within District 8.
- OTHER:** Anything not covered above will be followed by the state guidelines.

PLAYOFF ARRANGEMENTS:

- FIRST ROUND:** The first round of the playoffs will be on Friday or Saturday, time to be determined. Pairings will follow the WIAA 3A & 4A state football brackets.
- SECOND ROUND:** Pairings will follow the WIAA 3A & 4A state football brackets.
- SEMI FINALS / FINALS** Site and game times are set by WIAA office.
- FINANCES:** First and Second rounds (WIAA bracket): WIAA District's will split the net income from their home games after game expenses with the WIAA District of the visiting team.
